FISHING WEEK (A FAN FAVORITE!) (1 week) 6 years old and up (5 years old with permission)

Spend a week learning fishing equipment basics and fishing in varied waters.

INTUITIVE SCOUT ARCHERY PROGRAM (4 weeks of opportunities!) 6 to 12 years old (5-1/2 years old with permission)

Connect with nature/self/other playing archery, survival skills, swimming, fishing, fire making, scout games! Play, relax, hang out with friends!

BOW MAKING AND ARROW MAKING PROGRAM (1 week) 11 years old and up

(Ages 9 and 10 by permission only)

Learn how to make a real wooden long bow. Learn rudimentary arrow construction for lightweight bows, (35 lbs or less). Limited enrollment (8 students). Option to make a reduced sized bow and/or arrow.

This is a scout camp that uses Airsoft to further engage the kids in developing awareness skills. Airsoft is a scout game employing toy guns. Learn listening skills, stalking skills, teamwork, improve intuitive and physical awareness. You must provide your own equipment.

Tuition: \$395 per week Deposit \$225, non-refundable, by March 1, required to hold your spot.

Drop ins for all classes are \$90 per day except for forging which is \$100 per day. No drop ins for bow making.
